## **Missoula County Outdoor Burning to be CLOSED as of July 2<sup>nd</sup> Fire Danger Remains Moderate**

**July 1, 2019, Missoula, Montana** – Fire officials with the Missoula County Fire Protection Association (MCFPA) have restricted debris burning (outdoor burning) starting Tuesday, July 2nd.

People who burned this spring should go check on their piles to make sure they are fully extinguished. While there are no restrictions at this time, we urge people to be careful with campfires and check for restrictions before recreating in Montana.
